Sir/Madam,

As you are aware that the Mid-Term/Term-I examinations for the classes VI-XII are scheduled from 16.09.2026 to 29.09.2026 for the session 2026-27 in JNVs. In this regard, the Time-Table of Mid-Term/Term-I examination for all classes is enclosed (Annexure -1) for dissemination to all JNVs.

The following points may be noted with respect to the conduct of Term-I exam: -

1. Time of the examination for all classes is 10.30 AM to 1.30 PM.
2. ROs will categorize all skill subjects introduced in the region in three groups i.e. Skill-I, Skill-II & Skill-III for class XI & XII and accordingly examination will be conducted as per time table.
3. Question Paper reading time of 15 minutes may be allowed for all classes.
4. The examination must be conducted in fair & transparent manner.
5. The safety & security of the students must be ensured by additional support & being vigilant during the period of exam. The supervised/preparatory classes may be arranged for classes not having exam on a particular day.
6. The counselor will have a close watch on the behavior of students during the exam period & provide support to the students as per the need.
7. The other modalities will be the same as mentioned in the Guidelines for fair and smooth conduct of examination 2024-25 wide letter no. F.No.: 12-9/2023-24/NVS(Acad.)/273-80 dated 21.08.2024 (Annexure-2).
8. The results of Mid Term/Term-I should be declared on or before 05.10.2026.
9. Minor changes in the time-table may be done by Regional Offices under intimation to NVS, Hqrs in case of exigency.
10. Result Analysis of Mid-Term/Term-I Exam is to be submitted to NVS, Hqrs in excel format A & B (copy enclosed) on or before 07.10.2026.

Sub. Guidelines for Fair & Smooth conduct of Examinations 2024-25 – reg.

Sir/Madam.

In continuation of the discussion held during DC conference and guidelines issued in PAP 2024-25 on the subject cited above, the following guidelines are being issued for ensuring smooth conduct of examinations in JNVs:-

1. The question papers for all subjects of Term I (for all the classes) and for Term II (Non-Board classes) as well as question papers of all subjects of Pre-Board – II of Board classes are to be arranged at the Regional Office level with the help of linked NLI. The question paper for 1st Pre-Board will be provided by NVS Hqrs.
2. The RO will share the encrypted question papers and password on the same day of examination to the JNVs.
3. The Principal should have a separate email for question papers and s/he only should have access to the password.
4. Taking printouts from email and photocopies of all question papers should be done under the surveillance of CCTV and close supervision of the Principal/Vice Principal.
5. The question paper should be kept in separate sealed envelopes for each examination room and to be opened only by invigilators at the time of the exam.
6. ROs must have the JNV-wise list of staff engaged for downloading the question paper for examination, printing of question papers, and examination in-charge.
7. Use of Mobile phones by staff should be prohibited during printing/ distribution of Question paper/ Invigilation duty.
8. If any incident of question paper leak is reported, the RO will take strict action against staff who are directly or indirectly involved in the question paper leak.
9. 10% of the evaluated answer books in all subjects should be verified by the Principal and Vice Principal.
10. Identification of low achievers will be done based on the performance of students in each exam.
11. Remedial teaching is to be taken up immediately after the diagnosis of low achievers strictly under the supervision of the Principal/Vice-Principal. A monthly review of the performance of low achievers will be done in all subjects and in case no improvement is observed, the strategies will be modified to achieve improvement in consultation with Cluster Incharge ACs.
12. Each Cluster In-charge AC must have subject wise cluster wise list of low achievers of each JNV and assist JNVs in planning strategies for improvement.

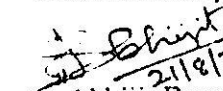
